



## COVID-19 - Support for businesses that pay little or no business rates

The government will provide additional Small Business Grant Scheme funding for local authorities to support small businesses that already pay little or no business rates because of small business rate relief (SBBR), rural rate relief (RRR) and tapered relief. This will provide a one-off grant of £10,000 to eligible businesses to help them meet their ongoing business costs.

Businesses are eligible if:

- they are based in England;
- they are a small business already in receipt of SBBR and/or RRR; and
- the business occupies the property.

No action is required to access the scheme. Your local authority should write to you if you are eligible for this grant. Any enquiries on eligibility for the reliefs and grants should be directed to the relevant local authority.
