All change in the world of R&D Tax Relief

Significant changes are coming into effect for companies claiming Research and Development (R&D) relief, for accounting periods commencing on or after 1 April 2024. A new 'merged' R&D scheme will be available to R&D qualifying claimant companies from this date.

Penalties if you missed the filing deadline

Have you missed the 31 January 2024 filing deadline for your 2022-23 self-assessment return? If you have missed the filing deadline, then you will be charged a $\pounds 100$ fixed penalty if your return is up to 3 months late, regardless of whether you owed tax or not.

There are a number of reasons why you might need to complete a self-assessment tax return. This includes if you are self-employed, a company director, have an annual income over £150,000 and / or have income from savings, investment or property.

19 March 2024 - PAYE and NIC deductions due for month ended 5 March 2024 (If you pay your tax electronically the due date is 22 March 2024).

19 March 2024 - Filing deadline for the CIS300 monthly return for the month ended 5 March 2024.

19 March 2024 - CIS tax deducted for the month ended 5 March 2024 is payable by today.
